In completion of three shows the Bethany College Intercollegiate Riding Team finished within the top ten intercollegiate teams in our zone.

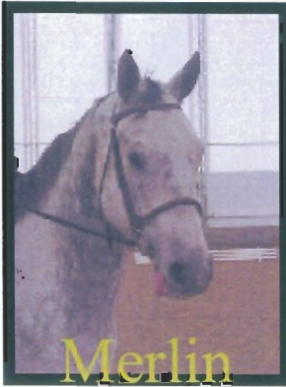
